

AUGUST 21, 2014 – PUBLIC HEARING

Minutes of a public hearing of the Town Board of the Town of Somers held on Thursday evening August 21, 2014 at 7:11 PM at the Town House, 335 Route 202, Somers, New York.

Also present were Kathleen R. Pacella, Town Clerk, Patricia Kalba, Deputy Town Clerk and Roland A Baroni, Jr., Town Attorney.

The Supervisor said that this was a public hearing with regard to the proposed extension of the Amawalk Shenorock Water District.

The Town Clerk presented affidavit of public notices of the public hearings that appeared in the Somers Record on August 7, 2014 and posted on the Town Clerk's bulletin board the same day.

The Supervisor declared the hearing open and asked for comments from the public.

The Supervisor explained that Mr. Radding was before the Board and expressed his desire to connect to the Water District. He said that to connect into the Water District he would have to pay for the Water District improvements since 2001. He said that Mr. Radding had agreed to do that and the Town Attorney had prepared a Resolution with regard to the extension.

The Town Attorney explained that the Resolution would be considered by Roll Call vote. He said that if adopted the Town Clerk's Office would provide him with three certified copies of the Resolution. He said that one would be filed with Westchester County Clerk, Division of Land Records and the other two would be filed with the New York State Comptroller.

Councilman Faulkner said that he liked what was being proposed and thought that this was a fair way to extend the District now and in the future. He said that everyone benefited from the extension.

There being no one to be heard on motion by Supervisor Morrissey, seconded by Councilman Ciriaco, the public hearing was declared closed at 7:15.
