RESOLVED, that the Town Board does hereby adopt the Preliminary Budget as the Final Budget for the Town of Somers.

The Supervisor said that it was in order to approve two (2) applications for temporary Holiday Displays. She said that she wanted to approve these this evening due to the Holiday Celebration which will be on December 6<sup>th</sup>.

Thereupon motion of Councilman Meyer, seconded by Councilman Clinchy, it was unanimously,

RESOLVED, that the Town Board does hereby accept and approve the two (2) applications for the Holiday Tree and Menorah to be displayed on the front lawn of the Town House.
